i would not recommend Overclocking laptops, as they get to hot and they dont OC far enough to make a difference.

dont do it. laptops generate enough heat as it is in a very small space. you'll end up hurting your laptop in the long run.

Go ahead do it. But at least fry me some eggs and bacon on it too

short answer: don't try

Its not worth it. Laptops go through intense and reasonably sophisticated engineering processes to achieve optimal performance/cooling capabilities. Mess with this and you mess with the "Feng Shui" of the laptop.
